**Food for All!**

One in six local people struggles with hunger. We envision a community in which no food is wasted and no one goes hungry.

**We Glean.**

Volunteers regularly drive our refrigerated truck to grocery stores, retail businesses, restaurants, orchards, and farm markets to collect food which would otherwise be discarded.

**We Grow.**

Volunteers provide opportunities for people to improve their nutrition and their neighborhoods through five community gardens. Dozens of local gardeners receive instruction from Master Gardeners, free plots, and garden supplies.

**We Give.**

Volunteers distribute the food we gather safely and free of charge to local food pantries, area agencies, and eight community meal sites made possible through our collaboration with local churches.

**We Make An Impact.**

Since our founding as a faith-based organization in 2005, we have recovered over three quarters of a million pounds of food and have fed thousands. Here are the numbers:

Pounds of food recovered since 2005.....	775,000
Truck Volunteers in 2015.....	65
Volunteer Gardeners.....	65
Agencies Served.....	24
Food Pantries.....	11
Community Gardens.....	5

Since **one in six** Washington County residents struggle with hunger, these few numbers clearly illustrate the difference Harvest of Hope volunteers have made in just a little over a decade.
